The Local Landmark Nomination Applications have been completed by the HPC for buildings and sites identified in the Certified Local Government funded Intensive Level Survey of Historic Resources of properties in the Village of Williamsville. The Applications list such things as the criteria that building/site meets from the Village code for landmark consideration, condition of the property, architectural features, photos, and identification map.

The next step is for the HPC to call public hearing for the proposed buildings/sites.

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The public hearings will be completed in two days. They are to be scheduled by the Village Administrator as follows:

- Thursday, April 3, 2014, North side of Main Street addresses, including the properties north of Main Street.
- Tuesday, April 8, 2014, South side of Main Street addresses, including the properties south of Main Street.

Persons wishing to send written comments or supplementary material prior to the public hearing can send it to Village Hall c/o the Village Administrator. This material must be received prior to the public hearing, if submitted to the Village Administrator at Village Hall or written comments may also be submitted for public record during the public hearing. No material will be accepted after the close of the public hearing for that address.

We ask the Village Administrator (Clerk) to send Notice to the Owners of the proposed buildings/sites according to Village code.

The HPC is inviting the public to submit a copy (not returnable) of any historic documentation for the proposed properties to be included in the file. This is an opportunity to share photos that may be in your personal collection, old newspaper articles, or written documentation of the history of the building/site.
