Mayor Kuzon: For my portion of the agenda this evening I have two items and no report. First is a resolution calling for a public hearing which would solicit comment on the proposal to change the method in which elected officials' salaries are amended. Basically now if there is an increase or decrease in elected officials' salaries it is subject to a separate public hearing. What we're proposing is rescinding this current provision and making elected officials' salaries part of the budget process and if this is changed they would then be included in the hearing on the budget in March. This basically calls for a public hearing for that.

ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Kibby, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED that the Village Clerk publish notice of Public Hearing to be held by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Williamsville on January 25, 1982 at 7:40 PM in the Municipal Building for the purpose of hearing all persons interested in discussing a proposed local law which would repeal Local Law #1 - 1972, dealing with salaries of elected officials.
