ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Baer, the public hearing was opened at 7:42 P.M.

Unanimously carried.

The Clerk read the notice of public hearing on a proposed local law which would amend Section 14.04(a)(2) of the Village Fence Code re: fences in exterior side yards.

Trustee Kibby read Section 14.04 as it presently is written. He then read the proposed revision as follows:

"No fence may be erected in any exterior side yard of a corner lot, or in that part of the rear yard of a corner lot that is closer to the common street line than is the side dwelling erected on said lot."

Trustee Kibby explained that this means that if you live on a corner lot and you have a rear yard with a fence that comes to the back of your house from the rear lot line, you may not go out further than the side of the house. It has to stay parallel with the corner of the house and go no further outside that line than the corner of the house.

No one from the audience appeared to speak in favor of or opposed to this proposal.

ON MOTION by Trustee Kibby, seconded by Mayor Kuzon, the public hearing was adjourned at 7:45 P.M.

ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Baer, the minutes of the regular meeting held January 26, 1987 were approved.

ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Kibby, the minutes of the public hearing on a proposed local law to Amend Section 60.32(21) of the Traffic Code, re: Parking on Main Street held January 26, 1987 were approved.

ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Kibby, the minutes of the public hearing on a proposed local law to amend Section 14.04(a)(3)(d) of the Fence Code held January 26, 1987 were approved.

Unanimously carried.

ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Kibby, the minutes of the public hearing on a proposed local law which would add a new paragraph to Section 50.00 (Sidewalks) held January 26, 1987 were approved.

ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Brenton, the minutes of the public hearing on a proposal to designate the Roneker Building as a historical site held January 26, 1987 were approved.

Unanimously carried.

ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Baer, it was moved to open a public hearing at 7:42 P.M. on a proposed local law which would amend Section 14.04(a)(2) of the Village Fence Code. (The public hearing was closed at 7:45 P.M.)

Unanimously carried.

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Mayor Kuzon reported he had been contacted by the United Way requesting that we host a meeting in the Village of Williamsville to discuss human service needs of the residents in the Village. United Way is doing this in Villages and Towns throughout Erie County, but before I commit to a meeting I would be interested in your input. Topics of discussion would include Human Service Needs, what needs are presently not being met and why, and what the roll, if any, the United Way could play in providing these services.

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Trustee Baer had no report and no resolutions.

Trustee Brenton read a letter from Mrs. Anthony Boguslawski, who lives at the corner of Garrison Road and Oakgrove Drive praising the Village sidewalk program. He said the program will be continuing this year.

Trustee Brenton reported that the water system showed a small profit last year. This was due primarily to the diligence of Don Dehn, the water maintenance man as well as the supervision of the Superintendent of Public Works. In conjunction with this, they recently, within a matter of a few days, found a substantial water main break on Lake Ledge Drive and repaired it. Shut down time was minimal and by replacing it in house, we saved the Village money.

ON MOTION by Trustee Brenton, seconded by Trustee Kibby, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED that the Village Clerk advertise for sealed bids for one (1) 1987 Single Axle Diesel Truck, Chassis and Cab Only, for the Department of Public Works. Bids to be opened February 20, 1987 at 10:00 A.M. in the Village offices, 5565 Main Street, Williamsville, New York under the terms of the standard bidding resolution.

ON MOTION by Trustee Brenton, seconded by Trustee Schlifke, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED that the Village Clerk advertise for sealed bids for one (1) High Compaction Bulk Refuse Type Rear Loading Truck Body, for the Department of Public Works. Bids to be opened February 20, 1987 at 10:30 A.M. in the Village offices, 5565 Main Street, Williamsville, New York under the terms of the Standard bidding resolution.

Trustee Kibby had no report and no resolutions.

ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Kibby, it was moved to suspend rules for public participation.

Unanimously carried.

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Mr. Morehouse from Morehouse Barber Shop on Main Street was not able to attend the public hearing on the Main Street parking held at the last meeting. He would just as soon see the parking limit kept at one hour but if it is changed to two hours he would like it from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. instead of 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. He feels the biggest offenders are the business men who have offices here in the Village and not the customers of the merchants.

Trustee Schlifke stated she is concerned that there were no representatives from the business community at the public hearing. The only expression of concern was a letter from the president of the Business Association that they wanted the change from one hour to two hour parking. The president of the Association was contacted and requested to provide additional information to the Board. Trustee Schlifke said she does not feel she has sufficient information to make and vote on the resolution for a parking change. Mr. Morehouse's suggestion to change the hours of limitation will be considered.

ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Kibby, it was moved to return to the regular agenda.

Unanimously carried.

ON MOTION by Mayor Kuzon, seconded by Trustee Brenton, the meeting was adjourned at 8:05 P.M.
