RESOLVED that Local Law #8-1987, amending the Village Local Law in relation to the granting of exemption from property taxation of a variable

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percentage of assessed valuation to those property owners 65 years of age or over, who have owned their home more than two years and whose annual income meets the following income criteria

\$ 0 - \$12,025	50%
\$12,026 - \$12,525	45%
\$12,526 - \$13,205	40%
\$13,206 - \$13,525	35%
\$13,526 - \$14,025	30%
\$14,026 - \$14,525	25%
\$14,526 - \$15,025	20%

which was the subject of a public hearing on November 23, 1987 is hereby adopted.
